



## **CRISIS PEER SUPPORT WORKER**

(21 hours per week)

Brantford Vocational Training Association is a mental health consumer/survivor organization providing peer support and employment for persons who have experienced mental health issues. All employees have lived experience with mental health issues. BVTA requires a **Crisis Peer Support Worker**, reporting to the Program Manager. Duties include assisting consumers in crisis with goals of recovery, building skills, finding housing, attending appointments, providing support and encouragement, role-modeling effective coping techniques and co-facilitating groups.

Qualifications include personal experience using the mental health system, secondary school diploma, ability to be a positive role model in their own recovery, maturity gained through life experience, basic computer skills and access to a vehicle. Some post-secondary courses in human services would be an asset.
